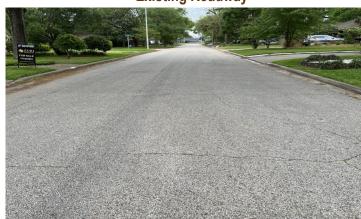

The amount of the EPA grant for this project is \$3,394,000.00, which has been fully expended. The share amounts above reflect the appropriate eligible work items as detailed in the project budget in the grant agreement. All future work completed will be paid with 100% Authority share.

The work completed during this period, including materials on-hand (MOH), corresponds to approximately 9.0% of the bid schedule, bringing the project earned value to 70.3%. Elapsed contract time is 312 of 470 calendar days (66.4%). There have been no approved change orders to the contract. Payment for MOH includes the following pump station components: 12' pipe gate, vertical pumps, and wet well, valve vault, intake and control building structural steel. The summary of completed work for the stated period is provided in the following table.

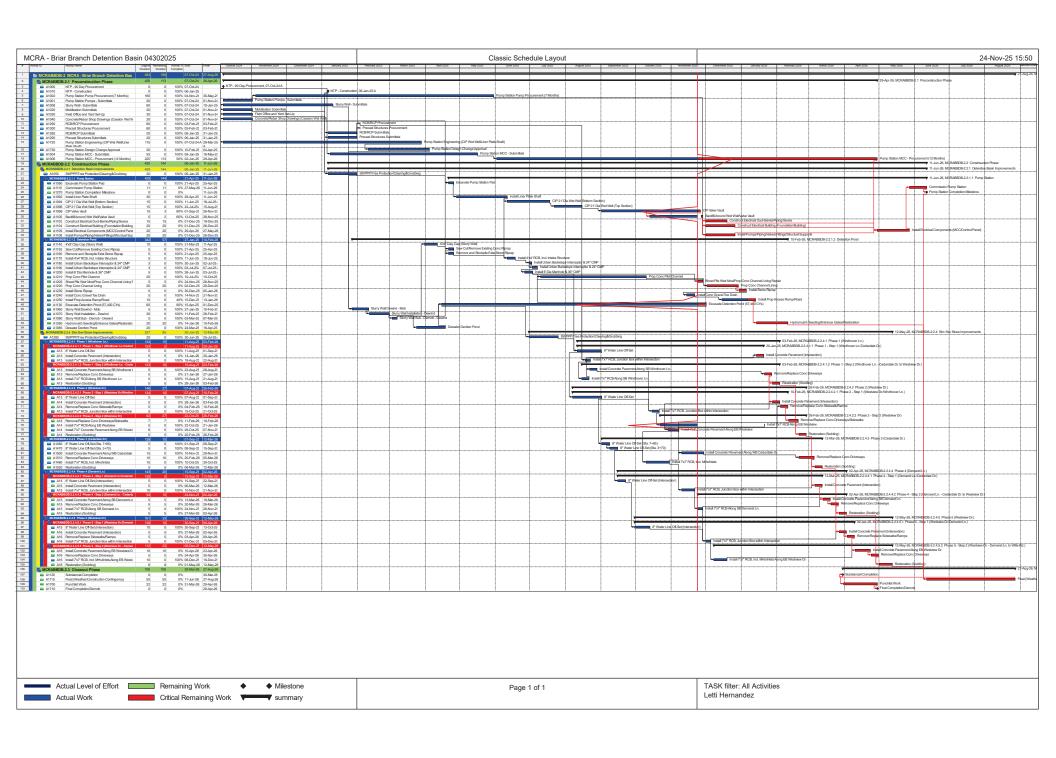

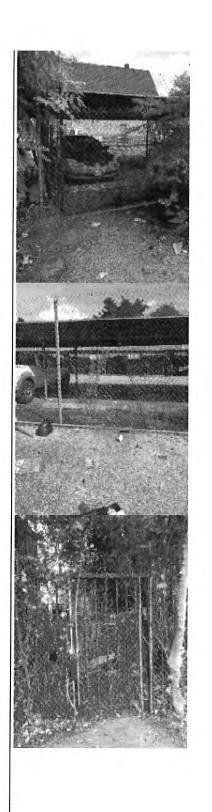

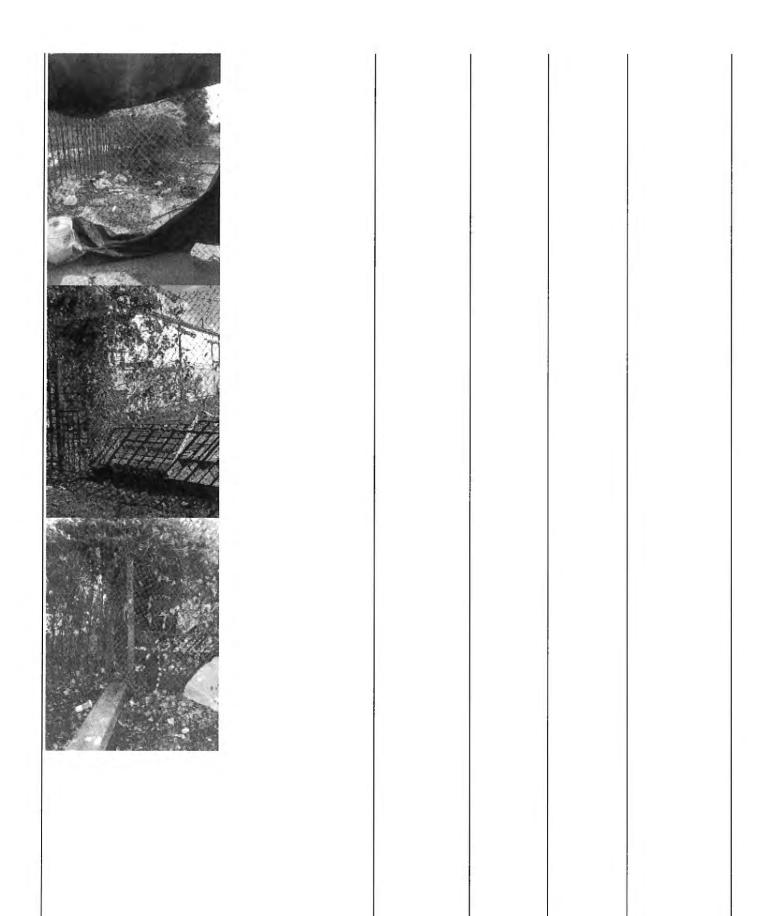
